Great Fall Discipleship Academy Classes!

Our studies began on Sunday September 21, and Tuesday September 23. You still can join any of these studies.

The **Old Testament Bible study and the Study for Midlife Adults are offered at** 6:30 on Sunday nights.

The **Leadership Training is offered** on Tuesday nights at 7:00. You have an opportunity to take one of the Sunday night groups and also the Tuesday evening leadership group if you desire. Below is a description of each group:

Entering the Old Testament, taught by Bob Sutton. This study of Hebrew scripture builds on daily Bible readings of 10-15 minutes, five days per week, followed by a weekly discussion on Sunday night. You will use a workbook (\$10) and utilize personal reflection and meditation on the scriptures as a means of Bible study. *Sunday nights at 6:30*

Forty-Sixty: A Study for Midlife Adults Who Want to Make a Difference, taught by Bill Shoulta. You will work with 10 issues faced by adults during their midlife years such as Aging Parents, Losses, Death, Retirement, and Myths and Realities of Midlife and Aging. The small group studies will also discuss scripture which applies to issues we face in this stage of life. A study book (\$10) is available for more in depth personal growth. *Sunday nights at 6:30*

Church Leadership Toolbox, taught by Ken Orr. This "wrenches in the trenches" approach to church leadership will teach you to make all those great leadership tips actually work for your committee, ministry group, or church organization. This is a series of practical hands-on exercises and Biblically based training sessions designed to teach you how to be an effective church leader. So grab your hard hat and get out your grease rag as we get down to the "nuts and bolts" of doing church leadership right! *Tuesday nights, 7:00-8:15*

The "Lead Like Jesus" simulcast will be hosted by our church on Friday, October 17th. It is sponsored by Campbellsville University and WJIE radio.
