PASTORAL
SEARCH COMMITTEE

No doubt - it's been a long, cold winter. Snow and ice have kept us from school and church and bundled under extra blankets. We wonder if we will ever see the sun, green grass and flowers again. We know that we will, but we forget these blessings when it is 14 degrees at midday with a wind chill of zero!

Maybe you are wondering "What about Melbourne Heights?. It's just been us "100" for some time. Maybe you feel like a sign once seen "I have done so much for so long with so little...." In other words. . . Will we make it?

Jeremiah wrote from Jerusalem to those still in exile:

For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Jeremiah 29:11

Hope. . . and a future. . . Through surveys, discussions and prayers during the past year the Search Committee members have heard our hopes and dreams of being a solid, vital part of the community – a body of believers who shares the love of God to all people, to those in our community and elsewhere who are hurting, lonely and in despair; to give people hope and a future. That sounds very much like God's plan for His church to me!

Over the past year your Pastoral Search Committee has acted on the belief that we weren't completing a human resource exercise. We've prayed that we, as a body of believers, will welcome with open arms the person God leads our way. We have prayed that the candidate with the right balance of love for the Lord, experience, leadership, and interpersonal skills has been feeling God's call on their life.

Your Search Committee asks for renewed vigor in your prayers. Let's claim as our own the words of the Lord from Jeremiah 29:11. God has plans for Melbourne Heights!

Spring is just around the corner. So is our Hope and our Future.
