## Dawnings Begins June 11

Back in March, a small group from our church had the opportunity to attend a retreat in Georgetown and learn about something called Dawnings. When the six of us came together for our first session, we all collectively wondered what "Dawnings" is and how Dawnings is different than other programs the church has tried in the past. By the time we left Saturday afternoon, we had experienced the Dawnings process for ourselves and were convinced that we, as a congregation, would benefit from it.

But that doesn't answer the question, "What is Dawnings?" Dawnings is a process that brings stakeholders (ie. people who care about our congregation and where we're headed) in our church together for ten meetings. In these ten meetings we will deepen our relationship with God, and allow God to show us God's vision for the future of this congregation. We will then find ways to live out this vision over the next ten to twelve months, which may include starting new things or ending old ones.

However, none of this can happen without you. So let me personally invite you to join us Wednesday, June 11 at 6:00pm for our first Dawnings session. You'll have the chance to learn a little more about this process and ask whatever questions you may have before you decide to be a part of the rest of the process. I look forward to seeing you then, and seeing how God uses Dawnings to build His kingdom through MHBC.
