Changes Are Coming to Our Newsletter

In October, the Western Recorder announced changes in their publication beginning in the new year. The Western Recorder will no longer be published every week, but rather will begin publishing every other week come January.

The Leadership Team at MHBC has been aware of this possible change for a few months, and has been in discussion about how this change will impact the way we communicate our news with you. At this point, we have decided to discontinue publishing our church newsletter in the Western Recorder at the end of December.

This decision has also prompted us to make other changes to our church newsletter as well. Beginning in January, we will no longer be producing weekly newsletters. Instead we will begin producing newsletters once a month. This will allow us to shift our attention away from announcements and upcoming events, and focus on the actual news happening at our church.

We will also attempt to deliver as much of this news online as possible. We are working with an e-newsletter service that will allow us to email our newsletter to anyone with an email address who signs up with the church. For those without email addresses, or who do not wish to sign up, we will continue to print paper copies of our newsletter as well.

Finally, in January, we will be unsubscribing everyone who currently receives the Western Recorder from our church's subscription plan (aside from our homebound members). If you would like to continue to receive the Western Recorder, at the church's discounted rate of \$11 per family, you will need to pay the church for your subscription prior to January.
